Poster Presentation Guidelines

- Information should be summarized using brief written statements, graphic materials, such as photographs, charts, graphs, and diagrams mounted on standard A0 size poster (841 mm x 1188 mm)
- Poster orientation must be portrait.
- Please include the conference logo on your poster, ideally in the bottom right corner. Attached, for your reference.
- Clear labels must be used for each section of the poster.
- Text should be of sufficient size for easy reading at a distance of 1.5 meter (minimum font size of 28-32)
- Title must be displayed clearly on the poster and please include the names of the author(s) and the institution(s) of origin
- Authors are responsible for printing their poster.
- The conference venue is offering printing support for a cost of USD 60 + tax charges. Once the payment is made, the print file needs to be shared 4 weeks prior to event date. Once the print file is confirmed, no changes can be made to the file. In case of any changes a new poster will be printed with the same applicable charges.
- If you decide to print your own poster, you will need to submit the poster to the "Speaker Room", wherein one of our team members would be assisting in mounting the poster at the Poster Gallery. Please do this on 24 October between 8am – 10am (i.e. prior to the conference start).

Display and presentation:

- Author/s are responsible for mounting and taking down their poster during the conference. Mounting tapes will be provided by the registration desk and "in the Speaker Room" if required.
- Posters will be on display on 24 26 October 2022 from 08:00 am 05:00 pm.
- Poster presenters should be available to discuss their posters with the conference participants during at least one of the lunch breaks.
- More information about who should present during which day will follow.

OPTIONAL EXTRA: Create your own video poster

- The ISPAH team are strongly encouraging researchers to turn their poster into a short video (max 120 seconds)
- This short video will be available for all congress participants "ondemand" and will also be shared via ISPAH Social media channels.
- We suggest recording a video in Landscape format, with the poster on one side, and a video of you talking on the other side. See this <u>example</u>.
- The video should be in MP4 Format and less than 120 seconds.
